

**Questions from Engineering Contractors concerning the Request for Proposals for Design of a Habitat Creation/Wave Attenuation Project at Mon Louis Island**

Q. In the RFP it mentions 550 tons of rock, but in your discussion yesterday I thought you said 330 tons – could you please clarify.

**A. 550 tons of rock is available for use in this project.**

Q. Does the 20 page limit include or exclude such pages as title pages, divider pages, cover letters etc?

**A. Twenty sheets – forty pages – is the limit specified in the RFP, so I guess we'll need to stick with that. If it becomes a problem, I don't see fonts being specified, so reducing from 12 to 11 or 10 might provide necessary wiggle room.**

Q. Will fee proposals be expected in submitted proposals?

**A. We will only expect fee proposals following the interviews and selection of top candidates.**

Q. There are discrepancies in the timeline published in the Request for Proposals. Could you clarify the timeline?
