Environmental Program Director

The Dauphin Island Sea Lab (DISL) is seeking applications for the position of Program Director of the Mobile Bay National Estuary Program (MBNEP).

Responsibilities: The Director will have primary responsibility for directing the activities of the MBNEP and overseeing implementation of a Comprehensive Conservation Management Plan. This position will elevate the MBNEP as an organization of importance throughout coastal Alabama and regionally among Gulf Coast states, resulting in further investment in estuary management, and promotion of the protection of the estuary as a community and economic priority. The Director will have in-depth knowledge of the geographical, ecological, cultural, and governmental aspects of the Mobile Bay estuarine system and will serve as a principal spokesperson and advocate for the MBNEP. The Director will be the chief representative for the program to local, state, and national audiences and will be the principal point of contact to the MBNEP management conference.

Qualifications: The qualifications for this position are a graduate degree in and fifteen or more years of technical or professional experience in environmental engineering, environmental science, land use planning, policy analysis, public/business administration, natural resource management, or related field of which at least seven years must have been in a supervisory, managerial or administrative capacity; or an equivalent combination of experience and education.

Salary: \$80,000 - \$90,000 negotiable based on experience.
