
- ▶ Fowl River spits and marshes are being affected by multiple stressors:
 - ▶ Lack of sediment to replenish marshes and stay ahead of sea level rise and subsidence
 - ▶ More frequent flooding and salt intrusion on the marshes increased erosion from high-frequency, low-amplitude boat wakes
 - ▶ Elevated nutrient concentrations.








Litter Gitter Collection Status as of 04/29/2019
