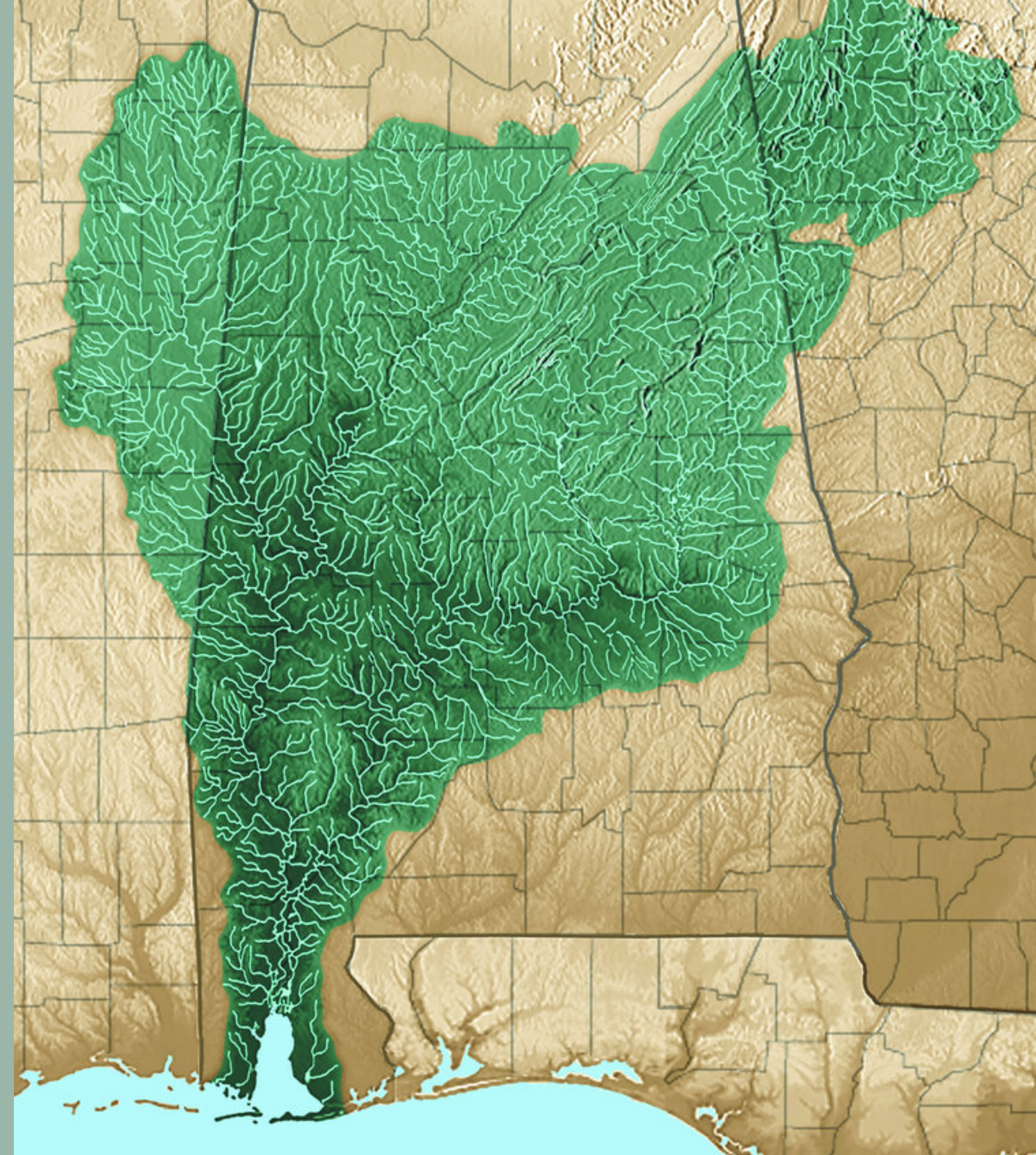

To create a sustainable infrastructure of local businesses that are direct action and long-term goal oriented.

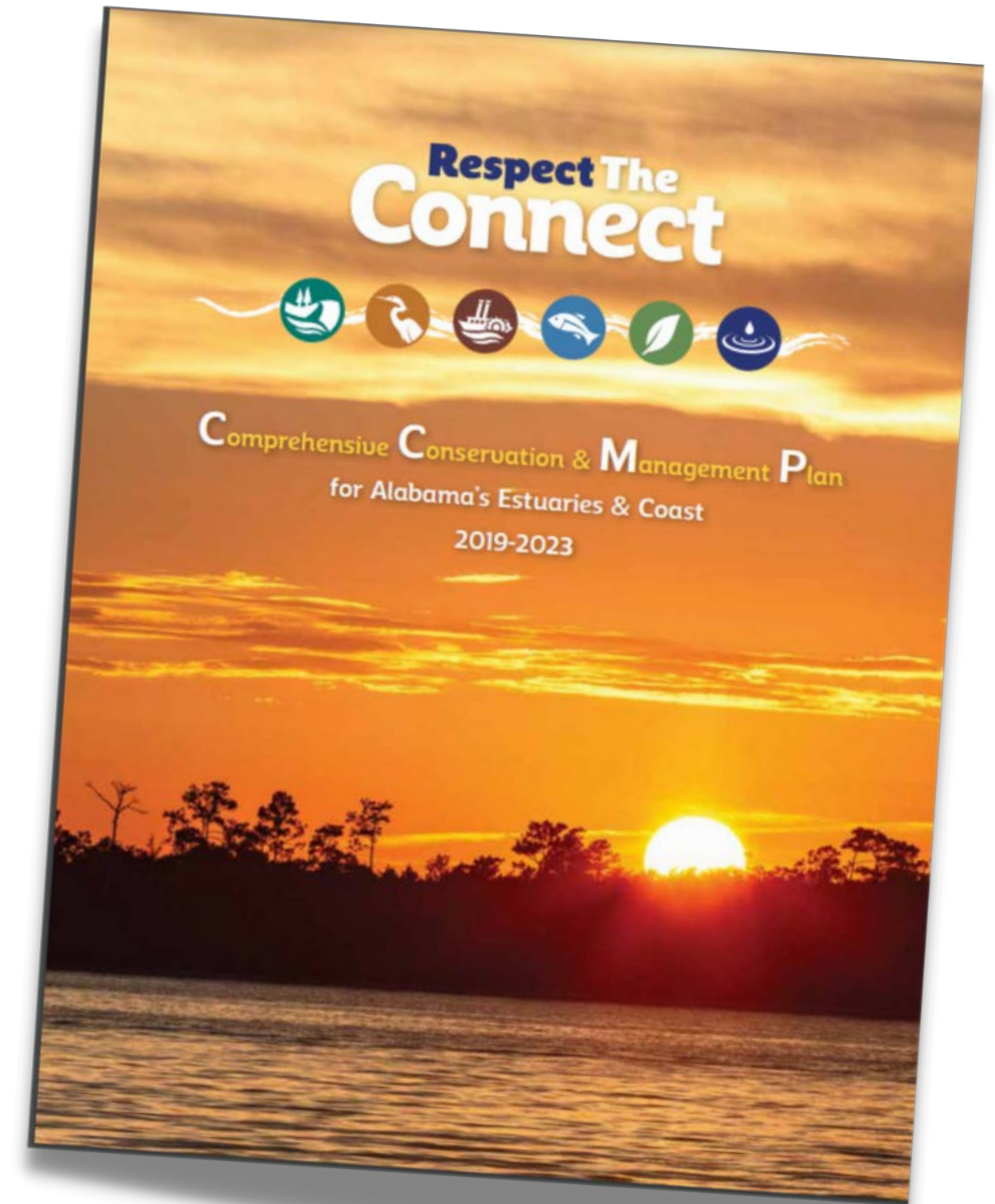
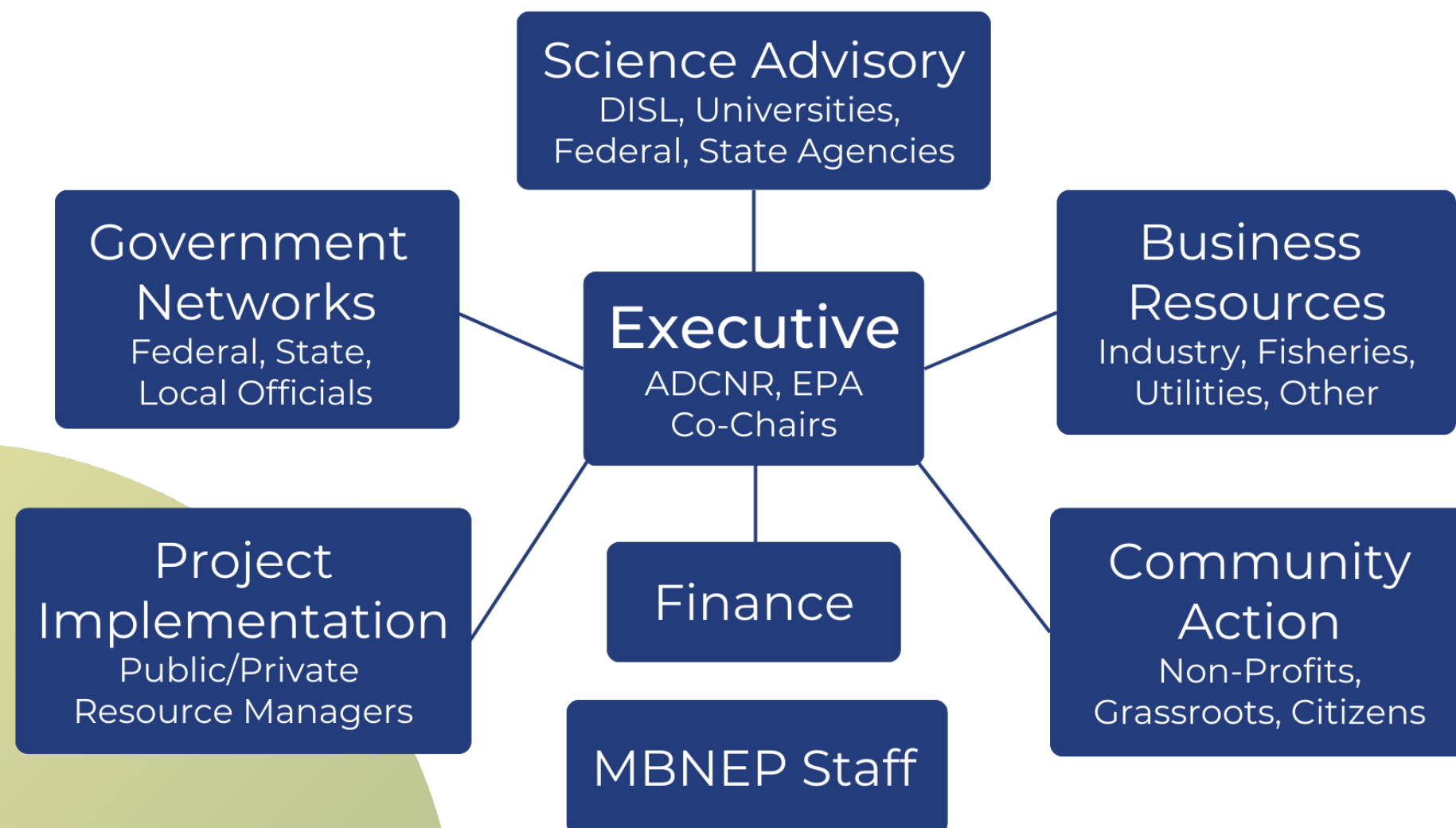
To connect small and large businesses with the community and government for joint action creating an environmentally friendly culture while maintaining and growing our robust local economy.
